

# LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS:

## Too Busy Not to Pray: A Very Practical Prayer Pattern (pp 45-84)

1. What have you learned about finding a regular, undistracted place that is personal to you, for praying? How has this changed with life season changes?
2. What do you think is required for our times in prayer to be "real"? What are the barriers to this that we must overcome? What has worked for you?
3. Bill Hybels, in *Too Busy Not to Pray*, says – “God does not want us to pile up impressive phrases. God wants us to talk to Him as friend or a father – authentically, reverently, personally, earnestly”. Respond to these ideas.
4. Read Psalm 63 in a very clear translation – what kind of prayer does David model for us? What moods, situations, issues are reflected in this honest Psalm that the Holy Spirit has designed?
5. Describe what the ACTS prayer exercise on Sunday was like for you. What parts of that experience will you want to incorporate in your regular praying?
